Focus on Dynamics

The Interdisciplinary Research Colloquium (IRC) of the International Graduate School for Dynamics in Logistics (IGS) is an annual event devoted to the interdisciplinary knowledge transfer. This year the IRC focusses primarily on Dynamics. It will be done in two ways. On the one hand in an interdisciplinary scientific workshop and on the other hand by a virtual journey from Asia to Bremen.

The main goal of the "journey" is to introduce the guest researchers, funded by the ERASMUS MUNDUS project cLINK (Centre of excellence for Learning, Innovation, Networking and Knowledge) and the resulting vivid co-operation. Thus, the current IRC is divided into three parts:

1. Introduction of the newest doctoral candidates of the IGS and of the cLINK guest researchers;
2. Interdisciplinary workshop on "Dynamics", prepared by the IGS doctoral candidates;
3. Poster session of the doctoral candidates about the current state of the individual research projects.
