Workshop held by Stefan Bausch

In the presentation of ideas, products and services, personal projection, charisma and physical presence are indispensable. In this, the presenter plays a decisive part. The audience measures how believable we are in the way we move, by our posture, and in the energy we project and the convincingness of our gestures and expressions. Therefore, the approach of the workshop is to strength the positive. The method will be to bring out what already exists in the personality and to develop this to its full potential. The goals of the workshop are:

- More commanding appearance in presentations
- Physical and vocal presence
- Projection of authenticity and credibility
- Strengthening of the individual ability to influence and convince
- Experiencing more of oneself and one's own effects on others
- Recognizing the personal preconditions and strengths, optimizing these and using them to advantage

Exercises will be done in posture and bearing, in eye contact, in authenticity and credibility, movement as methods of expression, gestures ("What do I do with my hands?"), voice and vocal techniques, presence, reflections on the effects upon others.

Any registration for a course offered by the IGS is binding after you receive a confirmation for your application. You are expected to attend class without exception.

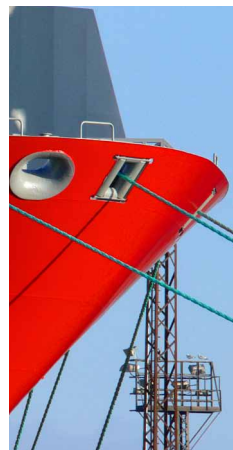
